A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDEN



Over the course of ninety remarkable years, the history of SharePoint Credit Union unfolds as a testament to resilience, adaptability, and community spirit. It all began in September 1933, when a group of dedicated Red Owl corporate and warehouse employees established the Red Owl Credit Union. This was fueled by a desire to navigate the challenging economic landscape of the Great Depression. With a modest \$250 lent by the store and an initial share value of \$0.25, the credit union's humble beginnings paved the way for a remarkable evolution. By December 31st, 1933, the credit union boasted 47 members, had approved 13 loans, and held a balance of \$97.89. Run by dedicated Red Owl employees who volunteered their time, the credit union gradually navigated its way through history.

Over the decades, the credit union evolved, embracing technological advancements to better serve its growing membership. From the installation of modern bookkeeping equipment in 1958 to becoming one of the few credit unions to embrace electronic operations using I.B.M. machines in 1961.

The journey continued with significant achievements such as crossing the \$10 million asset mark in 1977 and commemorating the 50th anniversary in 1983. With each milestone, the credit union expanded its reach and services, eventually adding Synder Drug Store employees in 1987. By 1990, the credit union underwent a rebranding, becoming Retail Employees Credit Union, and establishing its first independent location in St. Louis Park. The name change was well-suited as the credit union also included Super Valu, Lund's, Byerly's, Kowalski's, Jerry's and many other grocery stores.

SharePoint growth showed no signs of slowing with the launch of the Retail Employees website in 1998, leading to growth in checking accounts and credit card services. In 1999, the credit union surpassing \$100 million in assets, and the expansion into community counties adding to the credit unions outreach. This community expansion drove the name change to SharePoint Credit Union. With additional growth, the credit union purchased state-ofthe-art computer processing and expanded its product line to include business and mortgage loan originations.

In 2017, with over \$200 million in assets, SharePoint moved its headquarters to Bloomington, where a single purchased building could house all operations of accounting, marketing, lending, and technology. In 2018 SharePoint merged with West Financial Credit Union, adding Medina and Plymouth locations. The journey continued with the celebration of reaching \$300 million in assets in 2021.

Today, as SharePoint Credit Union proudly marks its 90th Anniversary, the narrative takes yet another exciting turn. The announcement of a merger with Star Choice Credit Union paints a picture of a vibrant future, where the union of two financial institutions promise even greater opportunities and resources for their members. SharePoint's history exemplifies a legacy of growth, spirit of community, and an unwavering dedication to adapting to the evolving needs of its members, setting a course for an even brighter tomorrow.
